Day Twenty-seven

Philippians 2:14-18

¹⁴Do everything without complaining or arguing, ¹⁵so that you may become blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a crooked and depraved generation, in which you shine like stars in the universe ¹⁶as you hold out the word of life—in order that I may boast on the day of Christ that I did not run or labor for nothing. ¹⁷But even if I am being poured out like a drink offering on the sacrifice and service coming from your faith, I am glad and rejoice with all of you. ¹⁸So you too should be glad and rejoice with me.

“Do everything in life without complaining or arguing” seems to jump off the page. It is so easy for those not in authority to gripe, murmur and complain about everything, but remember, God is the one in authority. Ultimately you are telling Him that you are not happy with the way He is running things.

Also, we are to be blameless and pure. Pure in our relationship with God and blameless in our relationship with others. Shining like stars in the night sky. Light sticking out against the black. The light here is God's word that we are holding out to people. See here that we are to live right before we hold out the truth.

Paul longs for these people to be who God wants them to be even if it means his life.
